

AGREEMENT FOR UNDERGROUND ELECTRIC SERVICE

This agreement made this _____ day of _____, 20__ between Pee Dee Electric Cooperative, Inc.,
(hereafter the "Cooperative") and _____ (hereafter "Member-Owner").

Witnesseth

Whereas, I, _____ am the owner of certain real estate in _____ County,
located at _____ and desire underground electric distribution facilities for service at

(Name of Subdivision)

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and the mutual obligations hereinafter set forth, it is agreed as follows:

1. Cooperative agrees to install, own and maintain a single-phase underground electric distribution system, including the 120/240-volt service lateral to the meter socket where applicable.
2. Member-Owner, prior to the installation of the underground electric distribution system to be constructed herewith, shall grant cooperative such rights and easements cooperative deems necessary to enable it to construct and maintain said underground system, including the service lateral.
3. Where applicable and when deemed necessary, cooperative will furnish and install conduits under all areas to be paved before underground system is constructed. Member-Owner agrees to notify cooperative at least five (5) workdays prior to paving any area, in order that cooperative may install conduits.
4. Member-Owner agrees:
 - a. to clear all obstructions, clearly mark all property lines and cause to be at final grade, within 6 inches, all areas wherein underground residential distribution is to be installed, before underground system construction begins; should the cooperative encounter any unforeseen obstacles during construction, the cooperative will contact the member-owner and re-negotiate contribution-in-aid prior to resuming work;
 - b. to have all underground lines, inclusive of water, sewer, septic tank and drain field, telephone, cable, electrical, etc., identified and clearly marked prior to underground electrical construction commencing;
 - c. that cooperative shall not be responsible for landscape damages which are incidental to underground electrical system construction work; and
 - d. that the meter socket will be in a location agreed to by the cooperative.
5. Before construction of the underground electric distribution facilities is begun, member-owner agrees to pay cooperative \$ _____, as contribution-in-aid for construction in accordance with the cooperative's current policies.
